On Wednesday I will be joining a group of colleagues on a visit to France, as part of the 'Growing Gastronomers' project. As part of the trip I will be visiting L'ecole St Vincent our partner school and taking along letters from Year 3 and English seed potatoes for all of the partner schools in Warwickshire, France and Estonia to grow and compare.
