## Staffing

## Let's Get Growing

We had a lovely start to the term on Monday when we joined together as a whole school preparing our gardens and allotment beds. The growing activities that we began are all leading to the Farmers Market that will take place on the last day of this half term Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> May.

I hope that you can see the fruits of our time, energy and funding from various sources used to develop our raised beds and orchard.

We would appreciate your help reminding the children, including pre-school children, that the gardening area is not a play area and needs to be respected and cared for. Please do not allow children to run around this area, spoil the beds, or throw soil or wood chippings before or after school. The trees and fruit bushes in the orchard are young and fragile and should not be touched.

## Safeguarding Children

As a response to feedback in the Parent Evaluations, and our on going review of the ways in which we endeavour to ensure the security and safety of all our children, we have considered access to the school building, particularly before and after school.

As a result, the following procedures will be implemented:

### 1. Early Risers –

- There will be one point of entry for parents to drop their children off at Early Risers in

the morning. This will be the door directly into 'The Hub'.

- Mrs Booth will be there to register the children and then send them to sort out their belongings for the day before they return to 'The Hub' for activities and breakfast, if they have ordered it.
2. **For activities that take place in 'The Hub' led by All Saints' Extra staff and outside providers -**
    - At the end of the day, following the departure of children who are going directly home, the Key Stage 2 door will be locked at 3.45pm.
    - Adults will not be able to openly access the building using this entrance.
    - Children at an activity in 'The Hub' will be handed over to parents directly from 'The Hub' door and be signed out.
  3. **Activities that take place in other areas, e.g. hall, field, library led by outside providers -**
    - Early Years and Key Stage 1 children will be supervised to classrooms where they change.
    - The Key Stage 2 door will be opened at 4.30 by the activity leader to admit parents and enable them to help their child change.
    - The activity leader will hand children over to an authorised collector when they are changed, or to All Saints' Extra staff for Chill Out.
    - The Key Stage 2 door will then be locked when all the children have departed.
    - Children staying at school after 4.30 will be handed over from 'The Hub'.
  4. **Key Stage 2 children –**
    - At the end of each session the adult leading the session will check with the children arrangements for going home: collection by adult, collection from the car park, walking home. They will then be dismissed in the normal way.
