Many of you will know that we have been supporting the children's centre, Akany Avoko, and Valentine for many years now. It has been a great joy to watch Valentine grow and develop from the 5 year old, who had been abandoned by her mother, into the responsible, caring young person of 16 that she now is. As a result of changes in Madagascar, the team at Akany Avoko have been very proactive in working to find families. As a result Valentine has now been able to return to her father and his new family and carry on with her schooling as a result of ongoing outreach support that is being given by the pastoral team from Akany Avoko.

Whilst we will continue to make a contribution to this ongoing support to enable Valentine to become fully independent, we are going to support a younger child placed at Akany Avoko itself.
