Safeguarding Children

KIK Alert

Following on from our own school concerns, I have been asked to pass on the following email to all parents received from Adrian Over the Education Safeguarding Manager /Local Authority Designated Officer

We have recently been alerted by one of the area Children's Social Care teams about an apparently new internet app called KIK.

We are told that this app is like Facebook but without the ability for users to put restrictions in place. It is provided by a Canadian based company who are not cooperative in terms of sharing information with the British Authorities even regarding child protection issues and the Police advise that in the USA, Australia and other countries they warn against use of KIK.

KIK is reported to be well known in these countries to be used by risky adults to gain access to children.

This came to light because an adult, thought to be local, targeted a number of young people who attend Warwickshire schools and sought to persuade/incite them to send indecent images.

The situation is being addressed through due procedures and the individual is being pursued by the Police.

We have been asked to bring this app and its associated risks to the attention of all schools and also to ask you to bring it to the attention of parents. I am aware that you are all addressing the issues of safe use of the internet and ICT through the curriculum and thought it might be useful to highlight this app as an example of unsafe use of the internet, particularly in respect of the 'opportunity' it offers all users anywhere to send messages to other people without restrictions, thus creating situations where young people can receive constant messages from people they do not know.
