We have received much positive feedback from parents about the online mathematics program, Mathletics and we have certainly noticed that children who use it regularly, have grown in their mathematical confidence over the year. Special thanks to PTFA who agreed to fund this for the initial year.

We have also received feedback from parents saying that they would like a way to support their child's spelling at home. To this end, we have managed to negotiate a special rate for Mathletics and its sister program, Spellodrome, for the forthcoming academic year. This is available NOW to all students and is accessed through the Mathletics website, with the same login details.

We would also like to say a huge thank you to PTFA who have agreed to fund half of the subscription to these programs for the next year- £411.

In September, we would appreciate a voluntary contribution of £4 per child, to cover the rest of the cost of enabling children to access these materials at home. A individual home subscription for these programs would normally cost £70 per child.
