First of all get onto the Learning Platform . Once on, you will need your CHILD's USER NAME and PASSWORD.

Type in the internet URL <http://www.welearn365.com> (or Google *welearn365*) and you will get to a list of all the

schools in Warwickshire. Use the little arrow to choose All Saints' Leek Wootton.

Log in using your CHILD'S USERNAME e.g. j.bloggs2@welearn365.com (they may not have a number)

Then put in their PASSWORD (teach them to NOT let the computer remember their log in details.)

Now they will enter the Learning Platform.

Espresso is under Resources (along with Athletics and other super websites.)

Espresso is under license and so you have the put in their special code. (You can get the computer to remember this code so you don't have to remember it each time. This is safe.)

Our school's USERNAME is Warwickshire29775 and PASSWORD is definite575 (these are case sensitive).

Most of Espresso content is now adapted for the i-pad and you can simply save the link onto the desk top which makes it easy to use.
