This years Jacob cross lambs have grown very well due to the fact they have made holes in every hedge and pretty much grazed the whole farm! The only medication the ewes and lambs have received is a wormer in May and they have eaten nothing but Goodrest grass, herbs, hedgerows and wild flowers. I have a limited supply as ever. Lambs come packed into freezer ready sections of chops and joints, breast of lamb and some stewing lamb. I can also supply those who like it with liver, kidney and heart. Lambs, as last year, are priced at £70 for half or £130 for a whole lamb. Our September lambs were WONDERFUL, Leek Wootton lamb was on the 'Specials' board at The Red Lion in Hunningham!
