Our next project: The Red Train

The red train is now probably nearly 20 years old. It was carefully moved from the old school when All Saints' was built in 1996. Generations of children have enjoyed climbing, driving and hiding in this favourite piece of equipment and it has been an especially important area for children as they start school and their buddies.

Sadly the train is now coming to the end of its life as various parts are beginning to need to be replaced.

The P.T.F.A. would like to replace the train with a suitable large piece of play equipment and, refurbishment of the safety surface, with a view to extending the play area slightly. Further research and investigation is needed but we feel that this is a project worthy of our focus.
