Parent Consultation Evenings

One of the great strengths of All Saints' is the way in which parents work together with the school to support each child's learning. Once again it was good to see so many parents coming along to our consultation evenings. I hope you found them useful and I apologise for the queues that formed. Thank you for being so patient.

Some of the feedback I received related to home learning and children's attitudes towards tasks. I am pleased so many of them engage enthusiastically with topic based tasks, learning important basic skills and using Mathletics and Spellodrome to good effect.

For those less enthusiastic home learners I will be clarifying my expectations during the coming weeks. I do expect all tasks to be completed in the children's own time, if this is not possible at home then we can find times during the day, such as playtimes and lunchtimes, to support them.

Regular reading, learning of tables and Mathletics activities are planned as Home Learning Tasks.

There is no doubt that children make better progress when they have a secure grasp of basic skills in literacy and numeracy and we have built up many systems in school, such as 'Torture Tables' to enable them to do this. I would appreciate your continued support in encouraging children to engage in all aspects of Home Learning and to sign their diaries regularly.

I will be monitoring reading and homework diaries during the coming weeks to raise the profile and importance of these activities.

How well are we doing? How can we improve?

Our vision at All Saints' is to do the best that we can for each child in order for them to achieve their best.

To help us do this I am sending out our annual parents Evaluation Form today. I would appreciate it if you would spend a short time considering the questions and sending in your response to us by Friday 21st March.

We take your responses very seriously and use them to evaluate how well we have met your needs during the past year and to inform school developments and improvements.
