## Mrs P's Pot of Gold! Helping you to make a difference!

Thank you very much to everybody who has sent in ideas. They are all very different and I'm sure they would all make a difference to groups of children in school. I have read your ideas very carefully and there are three that stand out for me. The reason they stand out from the rest is because they offer something different that we don't already do at All Saints'. The second reason is that they are all about caring and supporting each other through acts of kindness and quieter times of reflection.

We all have times when we are less happy than at other times for all sorts of reasons. 'Circle of Friends' will be a weekly time at lunchtimes when children who are feeling out of sorts can come to Wise classroom knowing that activities are organised and if they want to chat somebody is there for them. This super idea comes from Harriet Howson and Evie Prue who will be organising the activities they can buy with their 'Pot of Gold'. Mrs Duxbury will give a helping hand. The second 'Pot of Gold' goes to Amelia Hodgson and Theo Orton who both came up with a similar idea. This was a place where children might go if they wish to be quieter and pray or reflect on things that have happened. We have thought carefully about how we might be able to put this idea into action and have decided to ask Amelia and Theo to work with Mrs Duxbury and Mrs Batts to use their 'Pot of Gold' to set up prayer corners in each classroom.
