Feedback from Parent Evaluation Home Learning

Following our close look at home learning opportunities over the past year, the majority of replies received agreed that the balance of activities sent home was right. Approximately 20% of parents would like more home learning.

I was pleased to see that our recent reading initiative has resulted in many children reading more regularly.

I would like to emphasise how important it is that children complete the tasks that are set each week and tackle the extensions when they are able to.

Regular reading impacts greatly on the progress children make, not only in reading but also writing and learning across the curriculum.

I know from our in school monitoring that the vast majority of children are using Mathletics at home. I recommend both Mathletics and Spellodrome to you.

Playing 'Mathletics Live' does quicken up the children's calculation skills and this enables them to work more confidently on more complex number problems. The structure of the tasks enables children to gain confidence through consolidation and extend their learning as the levels are matched to their ability by the class teacher.
