Acting Deputy Head Appointment

I am pleased to announce that after a rigorous internal appointment process carried out by myself, governors and the Diocesan Director of Education, we have appointed Mrs Gail Duxbury as the Acting Head Teacher at All Saints'. She will take up this position in January for two terms.

Mrs Duxbury brings a wealth of experience to this position, not only from her time at All Saints but also from posts she has held in Warwickshire and other parts of the country.

I hope you will join with me in congratulating her on her move to the Senior Leadership Team at our school.

Green Leek Residential Kingswood 2015

This has also been a week when we look forward to the summer and particularly our plans for the residential visit to a Kingswood Centre in West Runton in Norfolk.

We will continue to have a two yearly cycle of 'Green Leek' residential experiences for children in Years 5 and 6 from both schools. One year beginning with 2015 we will visit Kingswood to enjoy a range of practical fieldwork experiences, using the rock pools and forest areas, to support learning in environmental science and geography. This will be combined with wider opportunities to apply ICT skills and enhance our computing and programming curriculum through the creation of animated movies. Physical and adventure activities complete an exciting week away.

The second year, 2016, will be a visit to Normandy in France where we will focus on learning more about Invaders and Liberators.

These visits will be open to all children in Years 5 and 6. Parents may choose to send their children on both visits or select either of the visits.

To secure a place on our visit to Kingswood in June 2015 a £50 deposit should be sent into school; by 30th September.

We have investigated the possibility of paying by standing order and whilst it is possible, it is very complex and has the danger of payments being allocated to the wrong school. In addition it would at least double the time spent on processing payments in the school office. For these reasons Kingswood payments should be paid by cheque made payable to W.C.C. and sent to Mrs

Hancocks in our office.

Class News

Highlights of the week.

Oak Class

This week in Oak the Year 1 children have been learning how to count on in ones and twos and creating their own doubles. We have read the story of 'Handa's Surprise' and made up our own stories. Reception have been thinking about their families and who lives in their house. We have made a large person to label.

Ash Class

In Ash Class we have been honing our research skills to find interesting dinosaur facts. We've been exploring 2D shapes and finding symmetry and right angles.

Wise Class has had another busy week with the children completing work in literacy on formal and informal language. In science we have started to grow cress seeds to test growth in different conditions. The real highlight however, was yesterday when Peer Mediation sessions took place. We joined with Year 5 from Waller and the Year 6's from Burton Green to learn how to solve disputes or difficulties amongst friends skilfully. It was great to see all the children interacting and reminded us of the great benefits of being part of a federation!

Dudley Links with Bo, Sierra Leone

Last year we were invited to join with the Warwick Cluster of schools who have developed a longstanding link with schools in Bo in Sierra Leone. Our children also took part in 'The Day of the African Child in June'.

In ICT the term has begun with lessons on safety, how to keep yourself safe when accessing the internet. Rules have been shared with the children and the importance of keeping these emphasised. Tonight each child will bring a 'Responsible Internet Use' form. We would appreciate it if you would talk to your child about it and then sign and return it to school.
