## This week's news

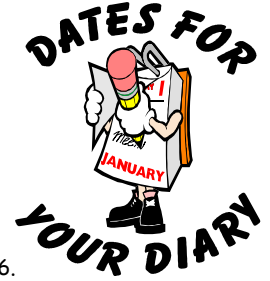
