Highlights of the week.

Oak Class: Final practices of the play have taken up a significant part of our week and all the children are doing really well. Please see Mrs Batts to let her know Reception children's going home arrangements for Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup>, Thursday 10<sup>th</sup>.

There will be no Wellie Wednesday until January 6<sup>th</sup>. Thank you so much for offers to help hear readers in Oak Class. Please pop by the office to get information for your DBS check.

Ash Class: We've explored poetry this week, looking for patterns and rhyme and spotting capital letters and full stops. The children have enjoyed learning and using new vocabulary and performing Christmas poems.

Waller Class: This week the children have amazed me with their problem solving skills! I was impressed by their use of clear recording, their investigative skills and sheer enthusiasm for large numbers. Their use of 'what if' questions and exceptional teamwork was also a major highlight.

We have been continuing our work on Greek myths, using figurative language such as powerful adjectives, exciting adverbs, similies, metaphors, alliteration and personification, to describe heroes and write a setting for our myth.

Wise Class: In Wise Class this week, we have worked hard to create exciting opening sentences for our historical stories. We used speech, vivid description of action, character and setting and questions to engage our audience. We also used our investigation skills in maths, whilst looking at perimeter and area...and all this whilst rehearsing busily for the Christmas Play!.
