Class Highlights of the Week:

Oak Class: Mrs Batts is so excited to be back! She missed everyone and was so proud of Oak Class. Lots of adults said how grown up they had been, well done.

This week, we are reading fantasy stories and structuring the beginning, middle and end in a story.

In maths we are learning new teen numbers and how to solve missing numbers in a number sentence.

On the 28th January Reception are going for a walk around the village to look for different types of houses. If anybody can help please see Mrs Batts. 9th February will be Chinese New Year Celebration Day.

Ash Class: In Ash, we've enjoyed sharing more Katie Morag stories and learning about her island home.

The children came up with lots of imaginative ideas for their own problems and events to add to the stories.

In maths we've been practising counting in multiples of 2 and dividing 2D shapes into halves and quarters.

Dudley Class

The inner poets have come forth this week! Dudley are really proud of their super hero simile poems, and so they should be! We have begun working on the grid method, so keep practicing your times tables.

Waller Class: This week we have been reading, analysing and enjoying narrative poetry and looking at the characteristics of the dashing romantic figure of The Highwayman in literature. The children have shown an excellent understanding of how to

interrogate texts and have developed their understanding of how figurative language and sentence types are used to create particular effects.

In maths we have been looking at place value for numbers up to, and above, six figures. We have been applying our maths skills to solve problems, explaining methods and reasoning.

In geography we used atlases and web sources (such as Google Earth) to draw an outline map of Europe, label countries and key features such as capital cities, rivers, mountains and seas.

Wise Class: Wise Class have enjoyed an active, busy week. We took part in the school athletics on Wednesday and performed with real team spirit and determination. We came 3rd out of 7. 'A Great Achievement!'

We have started our topic on the Mayan Civilisation by locating the area on the map and thinking about what we already know before we learn more.

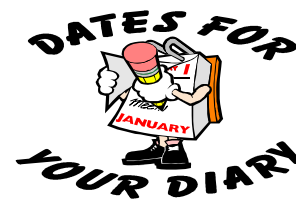
