This week's news

We are already half way through this half term and this week has certainly had a lot of varied activities in it from World Book Day to Mother's Day assembly and sports events.

I was delighted to be able to watch the football match between our Green Leek schools this week as well as the cross country race. It is good to see so many children enthusiastically participating in sports activities from Reception upwards. All Saints' Extra continues to extend these opportunities and are now working with Premier Active, Mr Clarke and Mr Cox as well as our own 'Phil' to provide specialist sports coaching after school in a wider range of activities. Years 3, 4 and 5 all benefit from specialist swimming and cricket tuition.

Class Highlights of the Week:

Oak Class: This week Reception have been working hard in their garden. We made bug pots and hotels. Some very decorative, natural mobiles have also been hung in our trees. Take a look.

We have all been busy making Mather's Day cards and baking for our mums.

Year 1's have been working hard learning number bonds up to 10.

Ash Class: The children in Oak and Ash enjoyed sharing their favourite books yesterday for World Book Day. We read 'The Enormous Crocodile' and used conjunctions to write posters to warn children of the crocodile's mischievous tricks.

Year 1 and 2 have learnt lots of new modelling skills and worked hard to make clay buildings for their Scottish islands. We look forward tom painting them next week.

Dudley Class: Years 3 and 4 have worked very hard to practise parts for the Easter performance, well done. Keep practising your acting and singing at home!. World book day was a real treat; everyone looked fantastic, thank you for your efforts. Dudley had a great time exploring the characters, scenes and sweets from Charlie and the Chocolate Factory.

Waller Class: This week in Maths, we have been developing written methods for multiplication. In Art/ DT we have been designing decorated crosses, which we plan to construct over the next two weeks. Meanwhile, in a packed and exciting week, we looked at how Roald Dahl describes his fascinating characters and wrote our own character descriptions in his style. We also found time to polish our performance for the Mother's Day assembly.

Wise Class: In Wise Class this week we have been

working on Mayan myths. We wrote our own exciting version and then for World Book Day yesterday we created our own scripts of the myth the 'Chocolate Tree'. We built puppet theatres, props and stage scenery and then 'acted' out our plays with great enthusiasm.

For home learning, the children have been asked to prepare a speech about their favourite book. This needs to be ready for Thursday 10th March.


