This week's news

This has been a busy week with all of Foundation Stage out and about on exciting visits to support this half term's topics. It is great to hear them talking enthusiastically about what they have learned.

Years 3 and 4 have been putting the final touches to their Easter dramatization and I have already been touched by the sincerity that they are bringing to their roles.

Thank you to everybody who has bought tickets for the quiz evening and to those people who have volunteered to help. We are going to have a good evening. I do appreciate your support and can't do it without you.

Class Highlights of the Week:

Oak Class: All of Oak Class enjoyed talking about houses in the past. The children loved looking at the old artefacts. They asked so many questions. We have been learning how to tell the time so get your watches out at home. Can you read o'clock and half past times.

We would really appreciate some more adult helpers to hear readers. If you have any spare time come and see Mrs Batts.

Ash Class: We've enjoyed reading Lemony Snicket's 'The Dark' and describing shadows using adjectives and powerful verbs. The children have written wonderful descriptions of creatures lurking in the dark.

Dudley Class: As a result of a lot of hard work, Dudley have finished their Lego WeDo projects. Rotating through 3 roles (builder, scribe and programmer), everyone worked brilliantly in their teams to build and instruct their robot, using motors, tilt sensors and motion sensors to command their model.

Waller Class: This week in maths we have been continuing to develop our understanding of written methods, for calculations, particularly short division or the bus stop method. It's really vital that the children have a quick recall of multiplication tables for this method, so please encourage them to spend

a few minutes each day practising.

In literacy we have been developing our comprehension skills.

Meanwhile, Year 4 have been working hard on their Easter performance and Year 5 are constructing their crosses to place around school.

Wise Class: In Wise Class this week we have been very busy baking 3 types of bread and researching the story behind the festival of the Passover. We are creating information leaflets about the 10 plagues of Egypt and will use imperative verbs to write cooking instructions.

In maths we have been solving long division questions using the standard written method- all children have made great progress this week and worked extremely hard.

The greenhouse in the raised bed garden is in need of completion. Waller have volunteered to finish it next half term, as it relates to work we are doing in science.
