This week's news

This week has been full of 'buzz' as we move nearer to the end of term. I hope that you enjoyed the time to look through your children's books this week. I know that I saw many proud faces sharing their learning with you. Children enjoyed their new class groupings on Wednesday and we welcomed some new faces who will join us in different classes throughout the school.

Year 5 and 6 have now begun to focus on their end of term performance 'Jungle Book', so the school is beginning to ring with 'The Bare Necessities' and other lively tunes.
