Class Highlights of the Week:

Oak Class: Reception have had a super, fun, busy week. Being here all week has meant we are all getting used to the daily class routines. This week we had PE for the first time and we all managed to find our clothes! In literacy, we have been reading Handa's Surprise. The story is set in Africa. We have made up our own stories with British animals in it. In maths we have been solving 1 more and 1 less problems. Reception had a bus with passengers getting off and on.

Wellie Wednesday will start this week on 28th September. Reception need a bag of old clothes and wellies.

Ash Class: The children have been excitedly adding

single digit numbers and are enjoying using our new Numicon resource. We've been drawing self-portraits and learning to proportion the face and study features using a mirror. The children were impressed by how much their drawings improved! We have lots of artists in Ash.

Dudley Class: This week, the children have been working really hard on their number lines and column addition in maths. During literacy, we have written about worries and explored how we have overcome them through story writing. A big well done goes to those children who are showing they are organised and ready to learn.

Waller Class: This week we have been investigating the effect of multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100 on decimal numbers. We have focused on place value and strategies for doubling and halving numbers. In literacy we have continued to read and enjoy the 'Just So Stories', identifying the ways in which Kipling engages the reader and planning our own story in his style.

Meanwhile, we have been developing our Tag Rugby and learning more about 'The Stone Age'.

Wise Class: Wise Class this week have had a change of English theme to non-chronological reports. We are learning to structure and order our writing into paragraphs and thinking about our intended audience. Maths this week has tested our thinking as we worked on algebra and orders of operations.

The children have been practising their cross country skills at lunchtimes and we look forward to an exciting season ahead of us.

SWIMMING

We are in desperate need for people to help with swimming on Tuesday. So far we only have one person signed up for the next four weeks. If you are able to help please speak to Mr Rodriguez and collect DBS information from Mrs Hancocks. Parents with children throughout the school are welcome to help. We already fund an additional swimming teacher and are unable to fund Teaching Assistants to take the children swimming.


