This week's news

As we are already more than half way through this half term I am including a countdown to Easter in this newsletter. There are a number of events that the children are specially practising for Mother's Day Assembly and the Easter Dramatization as well as the Easter Extravaganza. Get your bonnets ready and your boiled eggs to decorate. We would also appreciate donations of Easter eggs for this event. Please come along and join us, everybody is welcome.

Class Highlights of the Week:

Oak Class: We started a new unit in literacy this week, focusing on poetry and rhymes. After reading a selection of poems we began looking for rhyming pairs of words.

You are welcome next week to bring in any poetry favourites/books to share. Tens and units has been our work in maths. Using the numicon to make large numbers has really helped to visualise the numbers. Next Week: On Wednesday 22nd March in the afternoon, we will be visiting the Herbert Art Gallery for a Green Leek toy workshop and time in the museum. All Reception children need a packed lunch that day as we leave at 12pm.

Ash Class: We've been learning to use commas in lists this week and the children have written some wonderful character descriptions using lists of adjectives. The magical story 'The Whales' Song' has really fired the children's imaginations to write detailed descriptions of the illustrations and the whales.

In ICT year 2 have begun making presentations on our recent topics, showing good skills in saving and organising their work in folders.

Dudley Class: Dudley have worked hard on their fractions this week, practicing fractions of shape and number. Mathematics is great for fractions so keep going at home! In literacy we have been learning how to use speech marks whilst reading Fantastic Mr Fox. Please bring in your sports gear for next Fridays assembly.

Waller Class: This week in maths we have been looking at how to change improper fractions to mixed numbers and vice versa. We have also multiplied fractions by whole numbers.

Year 4 maths has focussed on reading, writing and ordering decimal numbers and solving word problems involving addition of numbers up to 10 000.

We have continued to find out more about Europe, this week researching some of Europe's major rivers.

Wise Class: In Year 6 this week we have been working hard on coordinates in maths. We have learnt how to plot points in all 4 quadrants and can now translate and reflect shapes across an axis. In literacy we have been creating tourism leaflets about Gunflint Lake in Minnesota as part of learning about the setting for our class book 'Wonderstruck'. We have been busy looking at light in science and had fun using torches to investigate shadows.


