Class Highlights of the Week:

Oak Class: This week Reception enjoyed a trip to the Herbert Art Gallery with Burton Green for a toy workshop. Year 1's presented their poems to the group which was lovely to share. Their confidence and performing skills have really matured. In Year 1 maths, we tried +10, -10, +1 and -1.

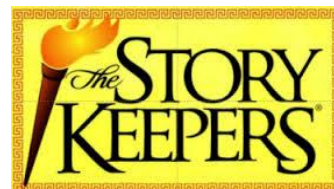
